Greene County I know all men by these presents, That I Gibal Watts knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die and bring my body and earthly habitation of sound and disposing memory do make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and disannulling all others mills whatever - to confirm this and this only to be my last Will and Testament.

Firsl I command my soul to God who gave it and my Body to the grave to be interred in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors herein after mentioned and as touching my worldly goods I give and dispose of the same in the following manner and form.

First My desire is that the property that came by my wife Nancy be given to her again Namely Beige Col Nomel Julia one Gray Horse Saddle & Bridle one Cow and calf, one Bed Furniture, one Trunk and four chairs - also it is my desire that she should have another Bed and furniture, and all the ballance of my Household and Kitchen furniture and that she have nothing further of my Estate whatever.

Secondly the ballance of my Estate of every description whatever to be sold on such terms and tinks as my Executors may deem most to the interest of my estate and that my black horse be sold be valued by three disinterested persons and have the choosing of his own master provided the person whom so chosen will give the power set on him, and after the whole of my estate is turned into money it is my Will that all my just debts be paid, the ballance to be divided Belween my Daughter Sarah and the child that my wife Nancy is now pregnant with and should either the child my wife is pregnant with or my Daughter Sarah die before they are raised it is my Will that the survivor shall have the whole of my Estate to be left, and should it to happen that either my Daughter Sarah or the child that my wife is pregnant with be raised till they are of age a manor - that it is my Will and desire that the property given them be equally distributed Belween my Brother Richard H. Watts and my Sisters Mary Watts and Martha Watts - Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint David J. Watts and Cordell H. Daniel my sole Executors to this my last Will and Testament.

Wright of the state and County aforesaid being weak in body  
but of sound mind have made and ordained this my  
last Will and Testament. -

- 1<sup>st</sup> I give my body to the dust to be interred at the despatch of my  
executors my soul I recommend to God who gives it.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> My Will is that all my just be paid by my executors  
as soon after my decease as practicable.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath to my two sons Robert Wright and Joseph  
Wright, the tract of land that I purchased of William Brown  
and not heretofore disposed of by me, to be equally divided  
according to quality and quantity.
- 4<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Wright the two tracts of land  
which I purchased of Grimes & Daniel and William Allen.
- 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Michael Wright Abney, Cynthia,  
Lemus, Shulton, Phoebe, Adeline, Clarkson as his full portion of  
my Estate.
- 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Booth, Abby, Zilla,  
Myrtice Little Jenny Amy, Child McWay, Charlotte Pleasant,  
a Girl, Fannie, Caroline, and Mary as her full portion of  
my Estate.
- 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Estey whatly Jenny George  
Smith, Young, Sarah, Hannah, Maria, Durbin, Miller as her full  
portion of my Estate.

8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Executors hereafter named Robert Wright  
Thomas, Wm. Joseph Wright and Thomas Booth as trustee for my
