Lewis Jenkins's Will

Georgia I am the name of God Amen. I Lewis Jenkins of the County of St. George State aforesaid being weak in body but of sound mind and desirous immorally having made and ordained this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all former Wills I make.

Item first My will & desire is that after my decease my Executors hereinafter named pay all my just debts.

Item 2nd I give unto my beloved wife Polly Jenkins all and singular my Estate real & personal during her natural life, and at her death the whole of my Estate real & personal to be divided into three equal parts; One part of which my will is done is shall be vested in my brother Elijah Jenkins and his heirs as a pre-emptive property forever and one other part or third my will & done is shall be equally divided among the children of my deceased brother Littlebury Jenkins (excepting Mrs. William Allen the eldest daughter of my brother aforesaid) in such manner as to be divided there between alive among them and their heirs forever. The remaining part or third my will & done is shall be equally divided between Mr. Shirley Jenkins and his heirs as a pre-emptive property forever there and there after between her and his children. Lastly I nominate & appoint my wife Polly Jenkins my Executor to my last will & my friends Col. Carter P. King & Hesling Graham Jenkins my Executors to this my last Will with full powers to carry the same into effect agreeable to the true intent and meaning thereof.
