

I Martha Asbury of the State of Georgia (and County of Greene being of sound mind and memory do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows
 Item 1st My will (and) desire is that at my death that all the property both real & personal which I may be possessed of be divided between the heirs of my body provided I have any & that if I (should) die (and) leave but one heir of my body that the whole of my Estate should go to that heir, (and) that if I should die and have no lawful heir of my body then (and) in that Case I give (and) bequeath to my beloved husband Richard Asbury two negroes which were left to me by Arthur H. Davis dec^d of the State of Virginia to wit one negro man named Ruffin (and) One negro woman named Plenda (and) her increase or the money which may arise from the sale of those negroes to him (and) his heirs forever & that if I (should) die (and) have no lawful heir of my body as above stated I then give (and) bequeath to my beloved niece Louisa E. H. Tatum the following negroes to wit One negro man named Isaac a negro woman named Winy One negro boy named Will One do^d named The Anderson one do^d named Williamson one negro girl named Darcus one boy named Henry together with their increase I also give her my wearing apparel together with all other property which I may be possessed of which are not herein before specifically Willed (and) in Case that I should die without any heir of my body (and) if my (said) niece Louisa E. H. Tatum should die without a lawful heir of her body then (and) in that Case I give the aforesaid property together with the increase thereof unto my nephew Lewis A. Collier son of William Smith Collier Item 2^d I give unto my Cousin Isaac Collier of Oglethorpe all the money or legacies that may be coming to me from the Estate of my sister Francis Davis dec^d (and) if the aforesaid legacy should be collected by me before my death then (and) in that Case my desire is that he receive (and) be paid out of the legacy left to Louisa Tatum the sum of two hundred Dollars
 Item 3^d I hereby nominate constitute (and) appoint my beloved husband Richard Asbury & Isaac Collier ^{the executors} of this my last Will (and) Testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand (and) seal this seventh day of June Eighteen hundred (and) Eighteen
