1st My will is that after my just debts being first paid I give the residue of my Estate in the following order I give to my daughter Rachel Cynthia Ralls, Eliza Green, the heirs of Allen Coleman and to Daniel Coleman one fifth and equal portion of what may comprise my Estate at my death.

2nd My will further is that that portion that I give to Eliza Green I give to her during her natural life and at her death if she should ^{die} without an heir then to go to the above named heirs of my body to be disposed of agreeable to the provisions of this will made for them

3rd My will further is that that portion of my Estate given to the heirs of Allen Coleman I give in trust to Daniel Coleman and Samuel Green for them to dispose of as trustees for the benefit of ^{and} him of Allen Coleman as they may think most advisable

4th My will further is that two certain notes of hand given to my Estate by Samuel Green & Daniel Coleman amounting to two hundred and ninety Dollars to be equally divided between my daughter Cynthia Ralls, and Samuel Green & Daniel Coleman in trust for the heirs of Allen Coleman

5th I appoint my dear Daniel Coleman and Samuel Green Executors to this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 29th of March 1828
