I Robert Gilliam of the State of Georgia and
County of Greene do hereby make this my last Will and Testament.
In the first place I desire that all my just debts be paid
Secondly I give (and bequeath) to my wife Sarah Gilliam all my property
both real and personal except eight negroes (viz) two to Polly Branawh due to
Joseph Gilliam due to John Wilbourn and due to Jack Wilbourn which eight
negroes my wife Sarah Gilliam has the privilege of naming which are
to be sold but are to be taken away in ten days after my death

one half of all the Balance of my Estate both real and personal to have
each share (and) share alike

3rd I give (and bequeath) to my three sons Martin Gilliam and John the
other half of my Estate both real (and) personal to have each share
(and) share alike

4th I will my Executors and hereby authorize them (after giving off my wife her
choice Bed & furniture) to make sales in the most (advantageous) manner of all of
the Balance of my Estate both real (and) personal for the purpose of making a
distribution of the same among my legatees, but wish them first before they make
any division of the proceeds of my Estate to pay all my just debts of my Estate

5th I do hereby make (and) ordain my wife Sarah the lawful Guardian of my
