

May 26th 1820

I Robert Gilliam of the State of Georgia and County of Greene do hereby make this my last Will and Testament.
In the first place I desire that all my just debts be paid.
Secondly I give (and bequeath to my wife Suskey Gilliam) all my property both real and personal except eight negroes (viz) two to Polly Brantley, two to Josiah & Eladon, two to Thos. Wilkenson (and) two to Jacob Wilkenson which eight negroes my wife Suskey Gilliam has the knowledge of receiving which my so pointed out are to be taken away in two days after my death.

In the name of God Amen.

I Lauchlin Wetmore of the County and State aforesaid finding myself in a declining state of health but of sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last will (and) Testament in manner (and) form as follows

1st I give (and bequeath to my wife Sarah one good Bed and) furniture that is her choice of my Bed (and) furniture

2nd I give (and bequeath to my wife Sarah and my youngest son Martin one half of all the Balances of my Estate both real and personal to have each share (and) share alike

3rd I give (and bequeath to my three sons Martin, William and John the other half of my Estate both real (and) personal to have each share (and) share alike

4th I Will my Executors and hereby authorize them (after giving off my wife her choice Bed & furniture) to make sales in the most advantageous manner of all of the Balances of my Estate both real (and) personal for the purpose of making a distribution of the same among my legators but wish them first before they make any division of the proceeds of my Estate to pay all my just debts of my Estate

5th I do hereby make (and) ordain my wife Sarah the lawful Guardian of my
