Green County being weak of body but of a sound mind and
memory do hereby constitute this to be my last will & testament
revoking all others heretofore by me made In the first
place I recommend my soul to God who gave it & my body to
be buried in a decent manner at the direction of my executor
hereinafter mentioned I do for my worldly goods which has
pleased God to bestow on me I have bequeathed in the following
manner viz

Item 1st I have bequeathed to my brother Joel Limenton two hundred
acres of my plantation I now live on him to have his choice
to lay it off as it suits him

Item 2nd I have bequeathed to my sister Margaret Hanken my
sixth share belonging thereto

Item 3rd I have the balance of my respects both real & personal
that is not will to my brother Joel & Sister Margaret to be
gold divided in the following manner viz one hundred
dollars to my brother Joel Limenton as soon as the money is
collected three hundred dollars to my sister Mary Limenton
children but for my executor to retain the money in his hand
until the children comes of age but without interest & the
balance to be equally divided amongst my brothers & sisters
now living.

I do hereby constitute & appoint my brother Joel Limenton
my lawful executor to this my last will & testament. In witness
whereof I have set my hand & seal this 7th day of March 1826
