

Ruthy Greenes Will

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- Georgia** In the name of J. B. Green, of Ruthey Green of the County of Tate aforesaid being now
 before me & much afflicted in body health but of sound mind & memory and being possessed in my own
 right (certain property) herein after named do think proper and do by these presents make this my last will & Testament
 (The first of all I give my soul to God who gave it me & my body I resign to do another duty in a decent Christian bur-
 iall)
- Item 1st** I give to Ruthey Eliphalet, Elizabeth Eliphalet, Mary Eliphalet, Benjamin, Mary Eliphalet, and
 Thomas Eliphalet the heirs of my daughter Nancy Eliphalet the following property to be equally divided
 among them and any heirs or heirs the may hereafter have, subject to a division as they shall come of age or many after
 the death of their mother Nancy Eliphalet the following property to wit. One negro woman named Fanny & her increase
 after my death one bed, stoves & furniture one large pot & small pot & oven.
- Item 2^d** I give to Ruthey Eliphalet one large trunk & to Mary Eliphalet one small trunk.
- Item 3^d** The property named in the second Item of my will, I will that my daughter Nancy Eliphalet shall have
 the use and possession of during her life.
- Item 4^d** The interest that I have or may have in the Contemplate of Land holding of I should draw and I will that my
 Executors shall be disposed of it as to for my daughter Nancy Eliphalet as a small tract of land of sufficient size
 for her and her childrens support with a good comfortable house upon it during her life. The eight dollar interest
 of said land I give to the heirs of Nancy Eliphalet & subject to an equal division among them at her death.
- Item 5^d** If there should be no residue left of my interest in said land I will that it shall be equally divided among my
 Children (except that part that would of right go to Nancy Eliphalet) which I give to her heirs above named
 but to be kept in the hands of my Executors for her and her childrens use as occasion may require and at her death
 to be equally divided among them.
- Item 6^d** I give to my son Philip H Green my flock of Hens.
- Item 7^d** I appoint my sons Augustus Green & Philip H Green my Executors to this my last will & Testament
 the testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this 5th of May in the year of Our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty two
