Item 2^d I give to Ruthey Fitzpatrick, Elizabeth Fitzpatrick, Mary Fitzpatrick, Benjamin Fitzpatrick and
James Fitzpatrick they being the heirs of my daughter Nancy Fitzpatrick the following property to be equally divided
among them and any heir or heirs she may hereafter have subject to a deduction as they shall come of age or marry after
the death of their mother Nancy Fitzpatrick the following property to me, one negro woman named Liddy, her income
after my death, one bed, bedding furniture, the carpet house pot & cover.

Item 3^d I give to Ruthey Fitzpatrick one large trunk & to Mary Fitzpatrick one small trunk.

Item 4^d Other property named at the second Item of my will, I will that my daughter Nancy Fitzpatrick shall have
the sum and proportion of during her life.

Item 5^d The interest that I have or may have in the Contingent Lands lottery if I should draw land still that my
Executor shall be despatched as to give my daughter Nancy Fitzpatrick one small tract of land of sufficient size
for her (and) her children support with a good comfortable house upon it during her life. The right title & interest
of said land I give to the heirs of Nancy Fitzpatrick & subject to an equal division among them at her death.

Item 6^d If there shall be a residue left of my interest in lands I will that it shall be equally divided among my
children except that part that would of right go to Nancy Fitzpatrick which I give to her heirs above named
but to be kept in the hands of my Executor for her (and) her children etc as occasion may require and at her death
to be equally divided among them.

Item 7^d I give to my son Philip to have my Works of Steer.

Item 8^d I appoint my son Augustus Green & Philip to have my Executors to this my last will & Testament
in testimony whereof I have set my hand (and) seal this 5th of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and forty six.
