 my last will and Testament as follows, that is to say

1st I wish such property as can be spared and that that my executors (who will hereafter
 be named) sees good fit should be sold (and) all my just debts paid
 2nd The balance of my property I wish it all kept together for the Support of my family, raising
 and schooling my children all as far as arithmetic, english, grammar, & Geography if convenient
 3rd I wish my executors to purchase a tract of land in some healthy place for my family to live
 on and this tract I am to live on on Fishing Creek to be sold whenever they think most advanta-
 geous (and) beneficial to my Estate

4th I wish my beloved wife Mary Daniel when my youngest child comes of age or marry
 to take her third or a child's part as she chooses, or before should she marry

5th When my children comes of age or marry I wish them to be paid off by my executors
 a proportionable part of what will be for each child as they comes of age or marry

6th For the management of my Estate I do hereby nominate (and) appoint for my executors
 John D Daniel Thomas Daniel and my son Henry F Daniel so soon as they becomes of age

I Henry Baldwin of the County of Greene in the State of Georgia do hereby certify that as all mortal men be subject to many perils diseases & sickness I was uncertain what time they shall depart out of this life therefore to the intent they may be always in readiness to die whensoever it shall please the almighty god to call them to eternity & from the dust they can to the dust they must return in the name of God amen Now this is all in my manner & form following to wit

Item (1) I give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Baldwin one negro woman by name Fidei one negro woman by name Nancy one negro boy by name Sebern one girl child by name Mary & the land whereon I now live beginning on the Creek on a sweet gum running up the Creek to the mouth of Howdens spring branch to badden spring to the corner running a North East Course to a stake corner running round to the beginning corner & two beds of furniture one desk & one black walnut table one pine slab & contents one horse Saddle one black water chest & this is hers so long as her widow hood I know longer & if she marries for the above named property to return to the estate again to be equally divided between my surviving children

Item (2) I give & bequeath to my daughter Lucy Reed one moiety of my estate

Item (3) I give & bequeath to my daughter Bernice Wade one moiety of my estate

Item (4) I give & bequeath unto my son Joseph Hart one moiety of my estate

Item (5) I give & bequeath to my daughter Susan Beck one moiety of my estate

Item (6) I give & bequeath unto my daughter Rebekah one moiety of my estate

Item (7) I give & bequeath unto my daughter Harriet one moiety of moiety of estate and one hundred dollars to be raised of my estate

Item (8) I wish the balance of my estate to be negroes to be hired out until my son John Baldwin becomes of age & then all of them to be sold with all the rest of my estate to wit horses cattle hogs & household & kitchen furniture plantation tools &c together with one piece of land in Newton township dist N 19 together with the balance of this tract &c
