When my children comes of age or marries I wish them to be paid off by my executors  
a proportionable part of what will be for each child as they comes of age or married

I Henry Baldwin of the County of Greene and State of Georgia do make and publish this my last will and testament as all mortal men be subject to many painful diseases & sicknesses & even uncertain what time they shall depart out of this life therefore to the interest they may be always in readiness to die whenever it shall please the almighty god to call them to eternity & from the dust they came to the dust they must return in the name of God amen Testifying all other manner & form following to wit

Item (1) I give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Baldwin one negro woman by name Jude one negro woman by name Nancy one negro boy by name Seben one girl child by name Lucy & the land wherein I now live beginning on the Creek or a spring running up the Creek to the mouth of Bowdoin spring branching to bowden spring to the corner bearing a North East course to a slate creek running round to the beginning corner there heads furniture one desk one brick walnut table one pine slab content one house Brick & one black wash chaff & this is hers so long as her widow hood & now longer & if she marries for the above named property to return to the estate again to be equally divided between my surviving children

Item (2) I give & bequeath to my daughter Lucy Head one moiety of my estate

Item (3) I give & bequeath to my daughter Penncaly Wade one moiety of my estate

Item (4) I give & bequeath unto my son Joseph Hart one moiety of my estate

Item (5) I give & bequeath to my daughter Susan Peck one moiety of my estate

Item (6) I give & bequeath unto my daughter Rebekah one moiety of my estate

Item (7) I give & bequeath unto my daughter Martha one moiety of my estate and one hundred dollars to be divided of my estate

Item (8) I wish the balance of my estate to be reserved until my son Jas Baldwin becomes of age & then all of them to be sold with all the rest of my estate to wit house cattle hogs & household & kitchen furniture plants told & together with one tract of land in Houston hundred Acre 1/4 together with the balance of this tract &c.
