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In the name of God Amen I Sarah Keal of the
County of Greene and State of Georgia I being now in better
County of perfect mind & memory and knowing that it is
pointed for all persons to die, do make & ordain this to be my
last Will and Testament. Viz
1st It is my desire that all my just debts be punctually
paid & to effect this if I have not means sufficient to pay
my charges that they shall be lived out annually upon
the amount that may be used for that purpose, be raised
2nd I give unto my son Ervin Keives one hundred dollars in
money. The balance of my Property after paying my just
debts I give unto his children if he should have any and if he
should not live to the age of twenty one years, or marry to
my Will and desire is that all the property of any kind
I have shall be equally divided among the children of
Susan R Randle of Morgan County at this time, and
landed I do appoint William Randle of Morgan Co
together with his Son James Randle when he becomes of
age & John L Roberson when he becomes of age as my
only Executors to this my last Will and Testament and
it is my desire in order that the intent of this Will may
not be defeated that each of my Executors when they
qualify shall give Bond with good security that the intent
& condition may be faithfully complied with In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this fourth of August 1821
