of York State of Georgia being weak in body but of sound mind
I now make knowning that it is my intention to die and
I desire this my last will & testament First of all I give my soul
to God who gave it Every body to the world to be buried in a
decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my
friends As touching such worldly goods as I have pleasure
had to bestow upon my wife Elizabeth in the following manner
by will that after my death that all my equity be
real personal be sold after all my just debts are paid
money arising from the sale of my property shall be used
in the purchase of Bonds Stock or put out upon interest at
discretion of my executors & that my wife Elizabeth retain
draw annually from the executors the sum of two hundred
fifty dollars during her life & that after her death the balance
of my estate go to the heirs of William Thompson & will
assign William Lewis my lawful executor to this my last
will & testament whereupon I set my hand & signed my seal
this 2nd day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred eighty five.
