

William S. Valley's Will

In the name of God Amen I William S. Valley of the County of Greene and State of Georgia being in perfect strength of mind & memory do make my old will this to be my last will & Testament.

My will is that all my debts be paid out of the income of crops as soon as possible and that my whole Estate be kept together my wife Eugenia S. Valley to keep all my children to out William S. Valley, Elizabeth S. Valley, Eugenia S. Valley, John W. Valley & Mary S. Valley to have them educated clothed & supported out of the proceeds of my farm & all the surplus money that may be at any time given to any relative may be used as the may see cause during her widowhood and my Children may become of age or marry they are to draw a Child's part of my Estate both male & female leaving it each woman a Child's part for her lifetime & for during her widowhood and death and of my children after drawing their part of my Estate die without an heir of their body the part they may have drawn shall revert to the my heirs And should my beloved wife Eugenia S. Valley Marry again she is to have allotted to her a Child's part of my Estate both real & personal to her & her heirs of her body and in case she shall be cause to remove from of the land I leave her out she shall be paid out of the next proceeds of my Estate the value in money of a Child's part of said tract of land I leave her out and my will is that my negro shall be kept on the plantation and not to be hired out in any Case until they are allotted to my heirs as they come of age or marry as above mentioned. (And lastly I constitute my beloved wife Eugenia of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all others herebefore made. And testifying whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth day of December 1825

A Codicil to the above Will

I hereby authorize my Executrix Eugenia S. Valley to sell at any time she may see cause a tract of land I have in Houston County lying in the third civil district Lot No. forty six also my interest in a tract of land lying on Ogeechee in Greene County that came to me by a will from Alexander Stewart deceased my Grand Father and further my will that my said Executrix may sell at private sale or public as she may see cause and to make payment either of said lands or either of them.
