make them all equal.  
Shew third At my death I will and bequeath  
that all my property both real &  
personal be sold except the amount  
given to my wife in Dower just to  
my Eirs hereafter mentioned the  
personal property to be sold at  
public and my real estate  
consisting of my horse place  
in said county consisting of  
235 acres 62 acres in said

County in Patterson survey known  
as the Baboon place to contain one  
entire lot of land the acres are  
thirteen 1/2 the said property  
I desire to be sold advantage either  
at public or private sale as they  
shall best and to the best inter-  
est of my heirs.

Shew fourth I will and bequeath that the  
proceeds of the sale of my  
property after pay all my just
