First My will is that all my just debts and
funeral expenses shall by my executor hereafter
named be paid out of my estate as soon after
my decease as shall by them be found convenient
I then give devise and bequeath to my beloved
wife Betty Little all the property both real and
personal of which I shall die seized and found
to have and to hold the same to her for and
during the term of her natural life after giving my
son Isaac W. Little one hundred dollars and my
daughter Susan W. Little one and half one bedstead
and bed and bedding one table and four chairs
its equivalent to hold the same to her use and heirs
for ever And it is further my will that as soon as
convenient after the decease of my beloved wife Betty
Little that all my estate both real and personal
to mixed of which she shall die seized and pos-
sessed by my executor hereafter named be be-
queathed and same thereof equally divided between
my twelve children to wit Corinda F. Little
Elizabeth C. Standley Martha J. Little Nancy E.
Whitney Mary C. Burr Gene W. Little Cynthia L.
Mrs. Henry F. Little William P. Little Isaac
J. Thomas Larna R. Hart Susan F. Little
And lastly I do nominate and appoint

William J. Little and Alfred H. Thomas to be the
executors of this my last will and testament.

Alfred H. Thomas will at my side without allowing
of administration and it is my last desire and prayer
that you shall in peace
