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and in the fall, Peter Water to have the return of the bond at North, if he does not take it at that place, then on account with keep it to find the bond 5th I saw my Henry Bugg ten dollars and direct that he be allowed to take out of my bond at the appointed value paying back to the value the amount she may be entitled at over said ten dollars.

Stone 8th I will and direct that the balance of my personal property remains her until the debt are paid and then to be equally divided by my children between of my children above mentioned, each to have her equal share.

I hereby constitute and appoint my son John L. Bugg my executor to carry into effect this will.

I signed, sealed, declared and published by John Bugg as his last will and testament in his presence who agreed the same as witnessed at the request of said testator and in his presence and in the presence of witnesses
