 State of Georgia on the 7th day of February

 estate to pay over to said Philip H. Bower
 all of my share or interest in said estate all
 of which I have to said Philip H. Bower free
 from all charges for his own property and
 benefit but of said of said property should not
 be considered in the support of the said Philip H.
 Bower during his natural life when I leave the
 remains due to my father to said Bower the
 sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to my
 daughter Miller White amounting the sum of
 five hundred dollars and to my second daughter
 Fannie Fela daughter of Miller White amounting
 fifty dollars after the above mentioned bequests
 are paid if there is any money or property left
 in the hands of my Executors I desire that the
 same be divided as follows the same be equal
 divided between all of my children to wit
