 support and four hundred dollars to be kept
 in the hands of my executor and she to have
 the interest, only the same during her
 life, and at her death the four hundred
 dollars to be equally divided between
 my bodily heirs.

Item 3 I desire that my executor pay my
 wife a little money into my first
 wife's hands.

Item 4 I desire that all my just debt be paid and
 the remainder be equally divided between
 my bodily heirs.

Item 5 I hereby revoke, annul and affirm my own
 will, and I do hereby make this my last
 will and testament.
