State of Georgia. In the name of God
the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I, Middleton B. Montgomery
of said State and County, do hereby certify that
I have on or later I must report that I have
seen it right and proper, that I should
as a Minister of the Gospel of a portion of the
property with which a kind Providence
has blessed me (contrary to the general law
of distribution of the State) I do therefore make
this my last will and Testament, hereby
and disavowing all others by me heretofore
made.

First, I desire and desire that my body be
buried in a decent and Christian manner
deceivable to my circumstances and condition
my life. My Body I trust, shall return to
God who gave it.

Second, In consideration of the long and kind
kindness, care, attention and efforts shown me by
Brother John Taylor, and to the said John Taylor
and his wife, I do hereby give and bequeath
to the said John Taylor, and his wife, all the
right of the said property, to give them as follows: I do
not wish that I bequeath and I give some
lands be surveyed off of the North side of the
said property forty acres and I give the said
tract of the said property, Georgia, and I give
five acres the East half of the said hundred and
I do hereby give and bequeath to the said John
Taylor and his wife five acres of land, the West
half of the said hundred and I give and bequeath
five to the said John Taylor.
Third, It is my wish and desire that except the
one hundred and fifty acres of land shown in
the second item of this my will to the said John
Taylor and Catherine Anna Taylor, the balance of
my entire property be not and should be
distributed amongst the persons entitled thereto
under the laws of distribution of the State and
in strict accordance therewith by my Executor
hereinafter appointed.
Fourth, I hereby nominate and appoint as my
Executor to this my last will and Testament my friend
and beloved Brother James M. Montgomery and
my good friend and Brother W. S. Riggs, the said
James M. Montgomery and W. S. Riggs, I do hereby
and bequeath that they will and desire
in good faith, to carry out my wishes in this
will and Testament.
