 further I direct my said debts to be paid

 myself that we will each of us pay one
 half of said debts

Item 2. I give and bequeath to my husband J. B.
 the residue of the property that I own
 over of every description whatever
 whether in possession or to be
 which I may be in anywise entitled
 at my death including my interest in
 the house and lot where my mother and
 grandfather now reside in the town of
 Dover the same fronting one hundred
 feet on Middle Street and extending
 back same with four hundred feet to
 Brown Street in trust for the sole and
 separate use of my three children to
 wit Raymond E. Willie B. and Nellie
 M. Walker share and share alike
 if any three children should die
 leaving no children then I direct
 that my property be divided equally
 between my brother J. B. for four parts
 and my sister Mary Jones share and
 share alike Nevertheless the property here-
 bequeathed in the

sollicit you trust to said Martin
for the sole benefit and use of
my loved children and to the effect
of only as mentioned in the above
I direct that my executor shall
not disturb my executor shall
further H. H. Deane in their personal
home where they have so long
lived for and shall not in any
my last illness and shall not
character to allow my executor to
have the use of my estate in any
lot free from any charge of rent
so long as he or shall deem it
prudent to being fully aware of
the circumstances which at present

I hereby nominate and appoint
John H. Hargis executor of this my
last will and testament and fully

belong to me with full power to
sell or in any way dispose of any
property that I now own or may here-
after be entitled to and deliver
proceeding thereof to the trustee W. H.
Martin mentioned in this will on
such terms and condition as the
said Hargis may deem to be
best interest of my said children
and the remaindermen mentioned in
this will

Item 5 I direct that said trustee W. H. Martin
shall invest the money that I

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to him by my executor if any should be
so paid for some rent paying real
estate to be held for the benefit of my
three adopted children until the youngest
shall become of age then to be equally
divided between them if they should
live so long
