Item 5th I will and direct that my executor hereinafter named, after paying any and all (usual expenses &c) that whatever part or collection of cash, rent, or sale of property shall be received in Georgia Rail Road stock as directed in strength of the will, he shall convert the interest of the beneficiaries under the will and keep only what of the stock is necessary to run the farm.

Item 6th I will and direct that should Wiley H. Baxter Colored man, on the place said property, hold his property as to the tract separate from Mariab & Warren Henry Morris.

Item 7th I will bequeath and desire that in the event that Mariab & Warren Henry Morris or Warren hold the same within the time of his whole interest according to the will, or the death of the surviving one I will to the place, but that during the time of his death, he or his heirs or assigns, shall have or dispose of any part of the land, stock or the Rail Road stock outside of the rents and interest as he before stated.

Item 8th I hereby nominate and appoint my friend David W. Spencer of the County of Gordon State of Georgia Executor of the

my last will and testament. And I direct that should he die or resign the trusteeship herein mentioned to him I direct the judge of the Superior Court appoint his executor having regard to the wishes of Mariab & Warren Henry Morris provided he in his official capacity can induce himself to permit to appoint and I desire that all the Executor & trustee should give good and suitable bond in view of the law.
