

I, I don't direct, that the land where
which I now reside, and which shall be con-
sidered, in equal number of acres by survey
to be given from East to West, as nearly as
can be done, so as to be in a parallel with
the boundary line, and after having
been so divided, I give to, and reserve to my
son James R. Noel, the north West part of
said lands, which includes the part of
my house & out buildings, and also my
Willow. The other part of said lands
I give and bequeath to my son John
R. Noel.

I, I have given to my children, to
wit: Emily C. Dyer, wife of Jesse H.
Dyer, Annanda W. C. Wythe, wife of
S. Wythe, Cynthia W. C. Wythe, wife of
Newborn, Elizabeth R. Newborn, wife of
John S. Newborn, Indella L. Newborn, wife of
William M. Newborn, & Harriet T. Baker,
wife of Thos. Baker, all that I own
them to have, except as hereafter named
and directed.

It is my desire and I so direct
that my daughter Alice R. Noel, shall re-
ceive from my estate, an annuity equal
to that, which has already been given to
my married daughter, and in the event
said Alice shall marry during the wide-
hood of my wife, that she shall receive
an annuity equal to that which my
married daughter have received. The law
to be taken out of property or effects, not
being above specified, and I should the
said Alice, remain single, and not
on her brother & myself, or either of us,
during our declining years, and in
that event, I desire and direct that my

daughter shall give her extra compensation
as in her testimony. He may think her
attention to us may be worth this to her
own and above the amount given to my
married daughter.

After the foregoing and above the
and promises of this will have been
carried into their desired effect, that
whatever of property consisting of realty
money personal property, or any indebted-
ness of debt due me or what is due of prop-
erty or indebtedness may have at my death,
shall be divided equally amongst my
daughters to wit: Emily C. Dyer, wife
of Jesse H. Dyer, Annanda W. C. Wythe,
wife of Saml. S. Wythe, Cynthia W. C. Wythe,
wife of Arch. Newborn, Elizabeth R. Newborn,
wife of John S. Newborn, Indella L. Newborn,
wife of Wm. M. Newborn, Harriet T. Baker,
wife of Thos. Baker, and of Harriet
T. Baker, wife of Thos. Baker.

I hereby constitute and appoint
my son James R. Noel, Executor
of this my last will and Testament,
as witness my hand and seal
this 27th day of Feb'y 1826.
