devise to my son *George Amistad*, and

land during her natural life unless she
marries, if she marries again she support
will cease from said land at her marriage.
My daughter *Somora Clementine Amistad*.
I give to her bequest to her fifty dollars.
I hereby constitute and appoint my wife

if any, be paid without delay, to my
nearest heirs, and I bequeath to my two sons
John B. Simonton, senior, and John
Margaret Simonton, all my lands situated

as follows, to-wit: Commenced at a pine knot
where is the original line of a lot of land
number three hundred and sixteen, same
line and the distance N. 33° E. to a pine
knot corner, thence a straight line (60)
feet S. 67° E. to a pine knot corner,
thence a straight line (108) feet and fifty
six inches S. 33° E. to a pine knot corner,
thence a straight line fifty feet S. 57°
