 thirty five years old and her two young
 set of children both boys she about married

 said woman and children to come
 with my wife untill said Henry shall
 arrive but twenty two years of age. I
 require without being required to give
 any account for him or any thing else
 to people in trust for my Daughter
 Caroline to come for him and to re-
 late all during his life from the
 control of my husband the way for
 the following property viz a small
 black girl by the name of Lucy about
 7 years old and her brother named
 John about four years old both the
 children of Harriet. He said to come
 with my wife untill the said Harriet
 arrives at the age of twenty one year of
 age without her being required to
 give any account for him or any thing else
 to people in trust for my Daughter
 Caroline to come for him and to re-
 late all during her natural life from
 the control of my husband. The said woman
 she may have my Negro woman Becky
 and her child William about 11 years
 old a bright girl. The said Negro
 to remain with our wife untill the
 said Caroline shall become twenty one
 years of age or Marries my wife not
 to be required to give any account for
 him or any thing else. The said property
 to given to the said Caroline or her

Son to be taken and held under the same
 restrictions & limitations as the property given
 my Daughters Jane in the second item
 of this will.
 Item 8th I give and bequest to my son Taylor the
 Dishes in trust for the use and support of
 my daughter Harriet. He shall bring
 her lifetime free from the control of any
 person. He may have a Negro
 woman named Jane about 25 years old
 & her two children Mary about 5 years old
 and David about five months old. He has
 power to remain with my wife untill my
 said daughter Harriet shall become twenty
 one years old or Marries my wife not to
 account for him or any thing else. The said
 property to given to the said Harriet or her
 Son to be taken and held by her under
 the same restrictions and limitations as the
 property given my Daughter Jane in the
 second item of this will.
 Item 9th I give and bequest unto my beloved and
 devoted wife Sarah People my Hares and
 Lot in the town of Newmarket & here I
 now reside my plantation as well as
 tract & yellow River in both tracts my
 horse and buggy horse hold & other per-
 tinent of said description my land at
 the plantation & wagon provisions of all
 kind both at the plantation & in my
 her cattle dogs gun powder all my
 or more or land, house, Negroes, debts
 demands to be pay my just debts in
 understanding together with any & equal
 about about 30 years old. Mary about
 27 years old. Lucy my old and said pro-
 perty. Lucy about 10 years old. My
 Negro woman Becky

and her Daughter Mary about 18
 years old, to hold during her natural
 life, provided she should live and dur-
 ing absence of the should twenty years
 any such estate the shall have only
 the usual share of my estate in full
 strength, the division to take place about
 the time of the Marriage between her
 and my adult children & to provide
 of those that are not adult, And it is my
 further my desire & will that my wife
 should raise and educate my seven
 children with such advantage as she
 shall see proper if not better clari-
 fying them anything for it as she is
 not working for the use of their property
 if any her former debts & favored
 collegiate Education be cannot pay in
 half the expenses out of his own part
 of my estate and my wife to pay in
 better half

Item 10. I hereby nominate and appoint my
 beloved wife Mary to keep my house
 and my four orphaned people, my in-
 gleman, David P. Thomas, and my like
 benevolent people Directors of one
 of this my last Will and Testament

I am contented whereof I the said William
 J. Peoples, have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this 7th day of April 1807
 witnessed by John Smith & wagon
 possession of all kind, at the plantation
 & hereafter the pay all my just
 now outstanding W. J. Peoples last
