 Joseph H. Rusk, Governor of the County of
 Georgia and the State of Georgia being
 of sound and disposing mind and memory
 and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs
 while I have strength so to do, do make
 and publish this my last will and testa-
 ment, hereby revoking all wills by me at
 any time heretofore made and first I com-
 mit my soul to God who gave it & my
 body to be buried

I will that all my just debts shall be paid with as little delay as possible.

I will that my only son, Ebenezer, together with my wife, shall have and share equal share with my other children the following lot in the town of Sandy Springs, a part of land lot number two hundred and fifty seven (257) in the 6th District of Gwinnett County, State of Georgia, viz. with said lot lying in the 6th dist. fronting 26 feet on the right and 20 feet ⁽¹⁰⁰⁾ on the left, and being a part of said lot designated by State Survey said lot containing 1/2 an acre more or less.

III.

I will that Willie Brown be permitted to remain on the old Ricketts farm containing four hundred acres more or less, said farm lying on the opposite side so long only as he shall continue to pay to my heirs the sum of two hundred and fifty (\$250) dollars annually.

IV. V.

I will that Dennis D. Singleton shall have two years from the date of this will to me to pay for sixty two and a half acres of land more or less being the Western part of land lot No 284, in the 6th District of Gwinnett County, State of Georgia, said land bounded as follows on the East by lands of J. C. Singleton, on the West by lands of Anderson Henderson, on the South by lands of Milton Melvin, on the North by other lands of said Dennis Singleton.

I will that a lot of land containing 28 acres in the South District of Hall County, State of Ga. be sold by my executors at whatever time they may think best for the interest of my heirs. And it is my will that neither lot of mine (Gold lot & mine) bounded and thirty two (32) in the Eleventh District of the First Section of Humphreys County, State of Ga. be also disposed of as the lot in said county above mentioned.

VI.

I will that all the rest of my real estate property including the house lot & more property and a house and lot I own in Dawsonville, together with any lands be held and controlled by my wife during her lifetime. I would also include the town notes and money may own in short, it is my will that my wife shall have full and entire control of all my effects of whatever kind.

VII.

Should my wife marry again it is my will that her husband shall have no control whatever of my property.
