 Item 1st I desire and direct that any body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner, my body I trust shall return to rest with God, who gave it to I hope for eternal life through the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Item 2nd I desire that all my just debts be paid without delay when due, my executor herein after named as I am unable to pay my creditors should be delayed of payment.
 Item 3rd I give and devise to my beloved wife the house and lot where we now live, and the little house and lot on right of Railway

joining Green, and likewise also three acres of land adjoining right of said road, left during the life of said Elizabeth and all the improvements thereon, and at her death I desire for my executor Saml D. W. Daniel to have all the above property mentioned.

Item 4th I give unto my wife during her life all the House held and to be the furniture I give her my plate during her life. Also one other lot of land, two hundred and twenty one, containing nearly seven acres more or less as the House and lot, I also give to my wife during her lifetime, tools as she may want and out house or outhouse and such other things as she may want if all I give to my wife all of the same during her life.

Item 5th I give the remaining portion of my estate to my beloved children as as they may have any portion thereof, I have already given to each of them some hundred dollars, to Martha Ann Matthews seven hundred, to Walter Charles ten hundred and thirty nine dollars (\$339.00) and fifty eight cents, to Jennie Elvira two hundred and fifty four dollars, to Eli L. McDaniel eight hundred dollars in land, to Virginia Lett three hundred and thirty nine dollars and fifty eight cents to John Woods six hundred dollars, to Willie Raymond one hundred and fifty dollars, to B. H. McDaniel four hundred and twenty three dollars and twenty five cents.

Item 6th I now desire that the remaining portion of my property be sold and debts collected and each of the heirs be made equal the remaining portion of my property being paid and ready to wit: Some thirty five hundred dollars in notes and bonds six ten or eighteen hundred dollars in
