Item 3rd If any of the amounts received from the estate
herein mentioned be invested in property
then the property bought shall be subject to
the bequest herein mentioned and shall
stand instead of said amounts received from
said estate.

Item 4th I hereby appoint and constitute my Sons
John W Gower and William M Gower
Executors of this my last will and testament
and desire that they assist their Father in
taking care of and protecting said property
