life the following described real estate
situated in the County of Loudoun
Virginia and known as the home place
with the appurtenances thereto appertaining

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and belonging. Also fifty acres of land
more or less known as the Little Mountain
place which property shall have power in
the event of my death to be sold or
otherwise disposed of in such a manner
as the trustees of said school property
shall deem proper and to be paid to the
said school property. Also except one lot of land situated
in the town of New Market in the
County of Shenandoah Virginia and
known as the lot of land of the
said school property and of said
town of New Market and public and
the power and authority is hereby given
to my beloved wife and daughter
should become necessary to the building
up of said town to sell or dispose of any
lot or land or of any trade or commerce
and to make good and
sufficient title to the same as the
law requires and the proceeds of the
sale or sale of any property for

 decided among the five children

 said to rule as in the fifth clause
 above.
