Item 4.

So it my will and desire, that in the distribution of my estate in kind, as provided by Item 3, there shall be three distinct portions appointed by the appraisers of said county.

heir his, her or their share, equalizing said shares, if necessary, by balance in money, if in kind, or by the liquidation of

Item 5.

The two several land accepted from my said wife Sallie C. Williams, which she has laid on my barren place, and which is reserved and hereby dedicated to the purpose of a burial ground for my family

and their descendants.

Item 6.

I hereby nominate and appoint my sons George & Williams and Siding & Williams, Executors of this my last will.
