

Elizabeth Martin Will

Know all men by these presents
that I Elizabeth Martin of the County & state aforesaid
at this time of sound mind & memory full of
years & reasonable Discretion and unimpaired
by any motion but to do justice to the parties interested
and fully aware that of the greatest uncertainty
of human life. Do ordain this my last will
& testament. First I resign my soul unto God whom
I gave it & my body to the dust from whence it
came. I should as my well beloved eldest son
Alan & Martin has already received his part of money
intended by me for him I give & bequeath unto
said Alan & Martin our Cow & calf. I do also
give and bequeath unto my second son Philip
Martin one hundred acres of land lying and being
in the County of Franklin & state aforesaid on
the waters of River adjoining to James Martin our
& this & same partition in the 8th district of Hall
County & state aforesaid containing 83 acres shown
by no. 37. together with our hundred dollars in
cash. I also give unto William Jory the Ch. W. of
my deceased daughter Charlotte ten dollars
and after paying my last debts I give unto my
then youngest sons Jas. & Martin & son W. Martin
& son J. Martin all the rest of my money to be
equally divided amongst them when collected
after paying out twenty dollars for my grand
child George H. Martin son of Philip Martin
which I give to the said George H. Martin
& twenty dollars which I give unto my grand
children James & Martin John Martin
& son Martin sons of Alan & Martin to be
equally divided between the three & to my
two youngest sons John W. Martin & son J. Martin

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of said lying in the County of Habersham & State
of Georgia appeared on the within of Henderson living among
Mush & others in the County of Franklin at the time
of the survey to gather with Hall and regular
then rights members and appraisers & lastly to my
son Philip Martin one further bed & furniture & one
side saddle the rest to be equally divided amongst
my youngest sons Saml & Wm M. & M J Martin
equally - And for the purpose of carrying this my
last will & testament into effect I hereby appoint
my son Philip Martin my Executor
in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 27th March 1832
