 will and testament that is to say first of all I
 give and recommend my soul into the hand of al-

 mend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian
 burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing
 doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
 receive the same again by the mighty power of
 God and as touching such worldly estate where-
 with it pleased God to bless me with in this life
 I give devise and dispose of in the following form
 and manner: That all my just debts be paid
 and funeral charges &c. I give and bequeath unto
 my beloved wife Esther all the land I possess at
 this time on the north east side of the Chattahoochee
 River it being a part of a lot of land known
 and distinguished in the plan of the tract devised
 by the number of 147 in said county during her
 natural life or widowhood then to become the property
 of my beloved son Enock Edwards and the heirs

profits thereof and support and maintain his mother
my wife Easter in a decent and prudent manner
And I Give and bequeath unto my well beloved daugh-
ter Easter two beds and furniture 4th I give and
bequeath unto my well beloved wife one third part of
all my personal property to wit stocks of all kinds
house hold and kitchen furniture so long as she
remains my widow, and when death or marriage take
place then what remains to be sold, ^{and} equally divi-
ded my lawful heirs 5th I give a bequeath to my
two son in laws John Whitaker and Newman Mills
one dollar each if required 6th I do further
ordain that all the balance of my property to wit
real and personal to wit land and negroes
Poly stock house hold and kitchen furniture and
farmed utensils are to be sold and equally divided
between my lawful heirs to wit Mr. Edwards, Martha
belord Elizabeth Mills Thomas Edwards James Edwards
Barbary Allen Pirella Flack Enoch Edwards Easter
Edwards and Easten Edwards to the two beds above
named and an equal part ~~and~~ with the rest of my
lawful heirs and the heirs of Rebecca Mills to
draw a child's part equal to one of the last above
named heirs the above division to be when all expen-
ses are defrayed of ~~for~~ given will and testament
and I give and bequeath unto my well beloved grand
daughter Taberry Manner daughter of Lucy
Whitaker fifteen dollars out of my estate I do hereby
Nominate and appoint William Edwards and Enoch Edwards
my true and lawful Executors of this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all former by me made
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this the twelfth day of January
Eighteen hundred and twenty six
