

In the name of God Amen) I George Peavours of the State of Georgia Habersham County this 16th Day of February 1829 being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory and blessed be God for the same) do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say) First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Rachel Peavours the Tract of Land where on I now live situated and lying on the East Side of Mount ain Creek I also give and bequeath unto my wife two other Tracts of Land one lying in Habersham and the other in Decatur County both of the State thereof) I also give and bequeath unto my wife all the Stock house hold and kitchen furniture her life time at her at her death) I Give and bequeath unto my Son Abraham Peavours the Tract of Land lying on the East Side mountain Creek Three hundred acres more or less to his heirs and assigns for Ever also) I give and bequeath unto my Son Abraham Peavours my Spotted Colt also one bed and furniture &c &c &c of the rest of my children at the Death of my wife) I want the balance of my Estate Equally divided be twixt the heirs of my body the two Tracts of Land and all the Stock house hold kitchen furniture &c &c (to wit) John Peavours Abraham Peavours and Isaac Peavours & Christopher Peavours and Elizabeth Nale and Sarah Mcbrackin all the heirs of my body unless I sell them two tracts in my life time if I do they shall be raised in the Division of the will) This being my desire I appoint my Son Abraham Peavours guardian for my wife her life time also Executor of my Estate Signed sealed and Delivered in the presence these names
