

Court of Ordinary November Term 1847.

It appearing to the Court that Elizabeth I. Allan and Emily C. Allan, minors of James Allan deceased have no Guardian and that they choose and consent that J. Allan be appointed. It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said J. Allan be and he is hereby appointed Guardian of the said Elizabeth I. and Emily upon giving Bond & Security, stating the oath prescribed by the law in such cases made and provided.

State of Georgia In the name of God Amen. I Henry Habersham County; Holerman of Gilmer County and State of Georgia being somewhat diseased in body, but of sound mind memory and understanding. Praise be God for it And considering the certainty of Death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and to the End I may be the better prepared to leave this world whenever it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make and declare this my last will and testament in the manner following to wit (viz) First and principally I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator, hoping for free pardon and Remission of all my sins and to enjoy everlasting happiness in the Heavenly Kingdom through Jesus Christ my Saviour. My Body I commend to the Earth at the discretion of my executor, herein after named; second, I will that all just debts as shall be by me owing at my death together with my Funeral Expenses and all charges touching of or otherwise concerning this my will shall in the first place out my Personal estate and Effects be fully paid, and satisfied. Then my will is that all the Residue, or remainder of my Estate both Real and personal wherewith it hath please and to intrust me I dispose of the same as follows

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(1847) First I will give and bequeath unto my beloved son Levi Holleman one good Feather Bed and Furniture one large Pot, one Flax wheel, being at Joshua Burgees South Carolina, Greenville District. Also all my working tools notes clothing and all other property or effects belonging to me, in my name or the name of any other person a part of the property being at the house of Benjamin Burgees. Maxfield Douthard & John Douthard and hereby revoking all other wills. I leave this as my last will and Testament, having set my hand & seal fully declaring this to be my last will and testament dated the Eleventh day of February Eighteen hundred and forty Seven. A.B. I also will, make constitute and appoint my beloved son Levi Holleman my executor to perform this my last will and testament In Witness &c. Set my hand and seal day and date above written and Signed by E. Cattlett

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Habersham County In open Court personally came Ezekiel Cattlett & Amanda A Adams & being duly & solemnly sworn Swore on oath that the above & foregoing writing was written at the request of Henry Holleman deceased, and that he declared the same at the time it was written to be his last will and testament, and that the said Henry Holleman, said after the same was written, to let him lay down & take a Rest & then he would get up and sign it, and that after he the said Henry layed down that he then and there died without signing the said will & deponent Ezekiel Cattlett further Swore that he wrote the above exactly after the instruction & orders of the said Henry Holleman & each deponent further Swore on oath that they considered the said Henry Holleman at the time the said will was written to be of sound disposing

Mind & memory & that he give the instructions & orders to write the same freely, without compulsion so far as they know or believe
