with I do hereby give and bequeath the same
According to the following terms to wit
That my beloved wife Nancy Adams shall keep
all my effects in her own power and possession
during her ~~natural~~ natural life time without
any dissent at any article what ever but at
her death what ever property or effects may
remain my own will is that the same be equally
divided among my children except my son
James Adams who shall have one hundred
Dollars first out of what estate there may
be and then his equal share of the balance
of the rest of my children
and I do here by ordain and establish this
to be my last will and testament viz annulling
all and every other will or bequest what ever
further written or verbal establishing this
as my last will and sign with mine own
hand this fifth day of December in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
five signed and acknowledged in presence of
