

In the name of God Amen I, Leatha Freeman of Habersham County and State of Georgia being somewhat decreased in body but of sound mind, memory and understanding (Praised be God for It) and considering the Certainty of Death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and to the end that I may be better prepared to leave this World whenever it shall please God to call me hence, do therefore make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say) First and principally I commend my soul into the Hands of Almighty God my Creator hoping for His pardon and Remission of all my sins and to enjoy everlasting happiness in the Heavenly Kingdom through Jesus Christ my Saviour, my Body I Commit to the Earth at the discretion of my Executors (herein after named)

Second I Will that all my Just debts as shall be by me owing at my death together with my funeral Expenses and all charges touching the proving of or otherwise concerning my last will, shall in the first place out of my personal estate and effects be fully paid and satisfied. Then my Will is that all the residue of my Estate both real and personal wherewith it has pleased God to intrust me, with I dispose of the same as follows viz)

First I Will give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Edith Freeman Two lots of Land numbers thirteen and thirty six in the second district of Habersham County and State of Georgia including the Miller farm of (being the home plantation) and part of lot number one hundred and ninety in the third district Habersham County Ga (Containing one hundred acres more or less) also my interest in lot number one hundred and ninety one in the third district Habersham Ga (It being the one ninth part) and all the benefits and profits arising from them, with all appurtenances arising thereunto belonging Houses, Mills, ways, waters Mineral &c one Livery Wagon and Harness, one Plantation Wagon, all my farming utensils, one Negro Man (Slave) named Sam, one Negro Woman (Slave) named Luker, all my household and Kitchen furniture

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all my stock of every kind, Horses cattle oxen hogs and
sheep during her natural life, also my ready Money notes &c.
I also Will that my son John Freeman shall be equal
with my Wife Edieeth Freeman (his Mother) in the before
named property and to remain in peaceable possession & free
privilege on the same during his natural life, I also give
and bequeeth unto my son John Freeman one Negro Man
(Slave) named Coffey, one feather bed, bedstead and furniture
during his natural life; and if he should die without a
lawfull heir then the said Negro man should be
living to be sold and the proceeds equally divided
amongst my other heirs — To my ^{Three} daughters Lydia Hunt, Thena
Adams, and Elizabeth Catlett and to them only or the heirs of
their body, I give and bequeeth one Negro Man (Slave) named Nat
two lots of Land (one on blue Creek) number one hundred and ~~eighty~~
eight third district Habersham County Ga, number seven
hundred and eighty fives in the first district and fourth section
Cherokee County Ga (at the time of survey) also my undivided
part of lot number twelve in the second district of Habersham
Ga (I having Deed and conveyed away part of said lot), to be ^{the proceeds} sold and
equally divided amongst them (with this exception that Edieeth Adams
daughter of James W Adams and Thena his Wife), that the said
Edieeth Adams receive out of Thena Adams part Eighty dollars
(more than any) of her other children. For the purpose of purchasing
a Horse for her use, I also Will make constitute and Appoint
my Wife Edieeth Freeman my Executrix and Ezekiel Catlett and
Ezekiel Mc Cray my Executors to do and perform this my last
Will and Testament, hereby Revoking all former Wills —
In ~~Witness~~ whereof I Septha Freeman to this my last Will and
Testament have set my hand and seal declaring this to be my last
Will and Testament dated the third day of January in the Year of
our Lord Eighteen hundred and Thirty nine (In presence of)
