Georgia I John King of the County & State
Habersham County, Aforesaid being mindful of Death
and the frailties of ~~life~~ and by the grace of God being
in possession of a sound disposing mind and memory and
will and also being desirous to dispose of the Good things
of this World that It hath pleased God to Bless me with
do make by Virtue of these presents this my Last Will
and Testament. 1st I Give and Bequeath unto my
two Oldest Sons William B. King and Abraham King a tract
of Land drawn to my name in the Late Land Lottery in the
State containing One Hundred and thirty Acres situate
in the Ninth district fourth section of Cherokee County Walker
County being Number Eighty six and whereas I have paid
for and given them a Lot of Land Lately they drew contain-
ing Forty Acres and have given them sums of Money
at various times to assist them in starting in the World as
also a good horse and saddle each when they first
left me I will and desire that the above named tract of
Land be all that they are entitled to receive of the property
and Effects I am now possessed of except a debt I have
on Dr Cotes for a Horse of Eighty Five Dollars with inter-
est which they may have if they collect it. 2nd I Give and

John W King and
Peter King the Entire Tract of Land and Premises —
whereon I now Reside being Lot Number fifty six in
the Twelfth district of Habersham and Number One
in the Eleventh district of the same and to be divided in
manner and form as follows. that is for John W King have
all that part of Number fifty six in the Twelfth that Lies
on the South East side of Deep Creek and that Peter King
have that part of said Lot that Lies on the North West
Side of said ^{Deep} Creek and all the Lot N^o one in the Eleventh
district of said County but it is my will that their Mother
my Dear Wife Nancy King still hold the possession and
still Reside where we now do during her Life time
having the Contrall so far as she wishes. and that the
proceeds of the Plantation apist in the Raising and Educ-
ating all the Minor Children 3^d and I Give to my Daughters
Amy Roe a Gray Mare Coll^d a Last Sprunge Coll^d Called Silas
the Gray Mares Coll^d and that my son Peter King have the
Coll^d the Bay Mare is now in foal^s with and If that fail
the first Coll^d from either of the Mares have ^{to be} raised for him
on the Farm. 4th and It is my will that my Wife Nancy
King have and hold possession and Contrall of all the
Ballance of property we are possessed of which is not Mentio-
ned ^{in the} foregoing for and during her Life Time and at her Death
to be Divided Amongst our Daughters as she may Direct or desire
only that our Daughter Margaret King have about a Double
Share on account of her affliction
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the
Twenty second Day of September in the year of our Lord
One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Five

the said John King as his Last
Will and Testament in the
