Gisk Patsy Crawford John Popham and
Nancy Adom I hereby give them nothing
in particular they having all been as well
provided for heretofore as I am able to
do - But I give and bequeath to my
beloved wife Ann Popham all my house
hold furniture all my stock of cattle ~~with~~
together with all my other perishable
property - and also I give unto her ~~and~~
one lot of land that I drew in the ~~late~~
late purchase in my own name known as
lot number ninety-two in the twenty-first
district of Muscogee County in said State
to her own individual use for ever and
do hereby appoint Gabriel Gisk my
lawful Executor of this my last will and
Testament and also I do appoint him
the said Gabriel Gisk the true and faithful
trustee of my said wife Ann for her and
in her name to take accept. have hold
use occupy and enjoy all my said
property both real and personal which I
hereby give to my said wife Ann and to
use accept and dispose of the same to
the only true and faithful use

~~will and convey~~ The same or sell and
and convey the same or any part
thereof that he may think proper
for her advantage. and the said
Gabriel Sick is hereby fully charged
and duly appointed by me here true
and lawful trustee and agent for her and
and in her name to do all things concerning
the said property as fully clearly and
lawfully as she herself could do.
