executrix of. This my last will

and enjoyed and I do hereby
utterly disallow revoke and
disannul all and every other
former testaments wills legacies
bequests executors by me in any
wise before named willed and
bequeathed ratifying this my
and no other to be my last
will and testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this day of January
one thousand eight hundred and
