of ground where old man Rich formerly
thence to the back line also one negro
man by the name of Granville one negro
woman by the name of Fanny and her child Rachel
I give my beloved daughter Martha L.
Wafford one negro girl by the name
of Ruth one feather bed and furniture
I give to my beloved daughter Mary S.
Wafford one negro girl by the name
of Channy one feather bed and furniture
I give to my beloved son William S.
Wafford all the remaining part of
the above said mentioned Tract of Land
being below the above described line
and the middle fork of Broad River also
one negro boy by the name of Sam
I reserve for the use of my father and
mother seven or five Acres of Land to
include the house where they now live
to be run off so as to include a reasonable
quantity of land fit for cultivation also
Six Acres in the upper part of my lower
field to extend from the river to the

use during their life time I also give
to my wife money Dafford all the
balance of my property met particular
pointed for the purpose of discharging
all my just debts which is to be paid
out of the property I have given to her
Entirely I likewise constitute and ap-
point to Anne Dafford my beloved
wife the Sole Executrix of this my
Last will and Testament. I further
acknowledge this to be my last will
and Testament
