1914-1920 disabled or invalid on Civil War pension roll

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Twenty eight disabled or invalid Civil War veterans were listed on Hall County Pension Roll. They were:

1. ADAMS, W.H., Gainesville. Pensioned 1914 through 1918. Cause for pension: Rupture. From White County. Died Dec 27, 1917. Paid to widow Mar. 29, 1918.

2. ALLEN, M.L., White County number 1. Pensioned 1914 through 1921. Cause for pension not given. Died Jan. 3, 1921.

3. ADAMS, Alfred, Clermont route 1. Pensioned 1914 through 1921. Company K, 2nd Regt. Cause for pension: gunshot wound in left foot. Witness: W.G.L. Butts, captain.

4. BROOM, Joseph, Gainesville. Pensioned 1914 through 1918. Company I, 34th Ga. Regt. Transferred to service roll 1917. Cause for pension: body wound May 1864. Witnesses: G.W. Scroggs, A.W. Hunt, Levi Broom.

5. BRYAN, A.P., 1921. Company B, 11th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension not given. Witnesses: W.S. Wills, H.D. Buffington, S.H. Frasier. Transferred from Banks County Oct. 19, 1920.

6. CHASTAIN, S.B., Pensioned 1914 through 1919. Company G, 49th Alabama Regt. Cause for pension: Disabled leg 1862. Witnesses: R.S. Smith, J.D. Oalin. Died May 25, 1919.

7. CLARK, N.B., Flowery Branch rts 4. Company I, 16th Ga. Regt. Cause of pension: loss of leg 1862. Witnesses: W.B. Binson, A. Rudolph. Died 5 p.m. Jan. 1, 1917. Paid funeral expenses to J.H. Davis Feb. 27, 1917.

8. CHILDERS, W.J., Oak-

wood. Company N, 38th Ga. Regt. Pensioned 1914 through 1915. Transferred to roll, Act. 1910.

9. DODD, John M. Pensioned 1914 through 1917. Cause for pension: arm wound. Dawson County. Reported dead by letter from J.W. Lindsey Jan. 22, 1918. Died May 19, 1971.

10. EDMONSON, J.C. Gainesville. Pensioned 1914 through 1916. Company K, 13th Ga. Regt. Reason for pension: loss of leg 1864. Died April 27, 1918.

11. GAILEY, A.C., Alto route 1. Company G, 1st Ga. Regt. Cause for pension body injury 1863. Witnesses: G. Hitchcock, M.D., T.C. Gower, MD; and W.C. Shore. Pensioned 1914 through 1921.

12. HENRY, C.V., Buford. Company D, 42nd Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: loss of finger 1865. Witnesses: R.F. Smith, MD, E.E. Dixon, MD, E.H. Clark, Capt. Co. D. Pensioned 1914 through 1918. Died Dec. 18, 1915. Paid to widow April 29, 1918.

13. McCLURE, R.N., Gainesville. Company I, 82nd Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: varicose veins. Witnesses: R.F. Smith, MD, E.E. Dixon, MD. Pensioned 1914 through 1915. Died Nov. 19, 1915. Paid to widow April 19, 1918.

14. MASON, E.D., Flowery Branch route 3. Company C, Cobb Legions. Cause for pension: disabled arm 1863. Pensioned 1914 through 1916. Died Oct. 11, 1916.

15. PRUITT, Nathan. Company G, 24th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: loss of leg. Witnesses: A. Rudolph, Ordy. Pensioned 1914 through 1915. Died Dec. 17, 1913. Paid to widow April 17, 1914.

16. PUCKETT, D.H., Buford route 2. Company H, 26th Ga.

Regt. Cause for pension: disabled arm. Witnesses: R.F. Smith, MD, E.E. Dixon, MD. Pensioned 1914 through 1916. Transferred to Service Roll. Dec. 12, 1915.

17. POOL, J.B., Lula. Company I, 24th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: head wound. Witnesses: Levi Broom, Noah Martin. Pensioned 1914 through 1921.

18. REED, R.S., Oakwood

Company D, 56th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: running sores from old wound. Witnesses: W.N. Dyer, Ordy, W.G. Hamm, MD. Pensioned 1914 through 1915. Died 7 a.m. Jan. 1, 1915. Paid to widow Feb. 22, 1915.

19. REYNOLDS, W.W., Flowery Branch route 3. Company K, 60th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: loss of arm. Pensioned 1914 through 1921.

20. SMITH, J.M., Gainesville route 7. Company K, 43rd Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: body wound 1864. Witnesses: S.T. Looper MD, J.W. Oalin, MD. Pensioned 1914 through 1917. Transferred to Service Roll.

21. SMITH, Russell, Gainesville. Cobb Legions. Cause for pension: shoulder wound 1863. Witnesses: J.W. Oalin, MD. Pensioned 1914 through 1920. Died Sept. 19,

1920.

22. SULLINS, A.E., First National Bank. Capt. Kelly Company Cavalry. Cause for pension: disabled leg by fall. Witnesses: R.F. Smith, MD. Pensioned 1914 through 1921.

23. SMITH R.D., Gainesville route 8. Cause for pension: foot wound. Witnesses: T.O. Otwell. Pensioned 1914 through 1921.

24. SHORE, R.M., Lula route 2. Company A, 7th Ga. Cav.

Pensioned 1914 through 1917. Died May 1917.

25. TURNER, L.L. Company D, 21st Regt. Witnesses: H.L. Hawkins, A. Strickland. Pensioned 1914 through 1920. Transferred to Forsyth County Dec. 16, 1920. Company I, 38th Ga. Regt. Witnesses: C.A. Davenport, T.L. Lipscomb.

27. WHITE, G.B., Buford route 3. Entered Jan. 1864, Company A, 1st Ga. Regt.

Cause of pension: loss of eye. Witnesses: J.S. Pirkle, I.S. Hemfri, W.P. Wheeler, all of Forsyth County. Pensioned June 26, 1917 through 1921.

28. YOUNG, R.C., Flowery Branch. Entered July 3, 1861, Company A, 11th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: loss of arm 1862. Witnesses: A. Rudolph, Ordy. Pensioned 1914 through 1919. Transferred to Fulton County. Nov. 18, 1919.
