

Hall County history

Disabled or invalid soldiers of Civil war receiving pensions

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There is thin, well-handled, ledger placed on a top shelf in the County Clerk's office, Hall County Courthouse, that lists names of Civil War Veterans who received pensions because of their military service. The Act of 1910 was the Pension Act for this cause; therefore, veterans signed thereafter and later widows of these men applied for pensions. A special list of wounded in service gives much data.

The list of Disabled or Invalid Soldiers:

1. ADAMS, W.H., Gainesville, Ga. Pensioned 1914 through 1923. Cause for pension: Rupture. From White county. Died 12-27-1917. Pension paid to widow 3-20-1918.

2. ALLEN, M.L., White County. R.F.D. No. 1. Pension 1914 through 1920. Cause for pension not given. Died 1-3-1921.

3. ADAMS, Alfred, Clermont, Ga., Route 1. Pension 1914 through 1921. Co. K. 23rd Regt. Cause for pension: Gunshot wound, left foot. Witness: W.G.L. Butts, Capt.

4. BROOM, Joseph, Gainesville. Pension 1914 through 1916. Co. I, 24th Ga. Regt. Transferred to service roll 1917. Cause for pension: Body wound, May 1864. Witness: G.W. Scroggs, A.W. Hunt, Levi Broom.

5. BRYAN, A.P., Cause for pension not given: Co. B. 11 Ga. Regt. Witness: W.S. Wills; H.D. Buffington and S.H. Frasier. Transferred from Banks County 1918 October 1920.

6. CHASTAIN, S.B., Pension 1914 through 1919. Co. G., 49 Ala. Regt. Disabled leg 1862. Witness R.S. Smith and J.D. Oalin. Died May 25, 1919.

7. CLARK, N.B., Flowery Branch, Rte 4, Ga. Co. I, 10th Ga. Regt. Loss of leg 1862; witnesses: W.B. Binson, A. Rudolph. Pension from 1914 through 1917. Died 1-1-1917. Paid funeral expenses 2-27-17 to J.H. Davis.

CHILDERS, W.J., Oakwood, Ga., Co. N, 36th Ga. Regt. Pension 1914 through 1915. Trans-

ferred to Roll Act of 1910.

9. DODD, Jno. M., Cause for pension, arm wound. Dawson County. Pension 1914 through 1917. Reported dead by letter. Died 5-10-1917.

10. EDMONSON, J.C., Gainesville, Ga. Co. K, 13th Ga. Regt. Reason for pension: loss leg 1864. Pension 1914 through 1916. Died April 27, 1916.

11. GAILEY, A.C., Alto, Ga., Rte 1, Co. G Regt. 1 Ga., Body injury 1863. Witness: G. Hitchcock MD, T.C. Gewer MD, and W.C. Shore. Pension 1914 through 1921.

12. HENRY, C.V., Buford, Ga., Co. D 42nd Ga. Regt. Loss finger 1865. Witness: R.F. Smith MD, E.E. Dixon MD, E.H. Clark, Capt. Co. D. Pension 1914 through 1916, paid to widow 4-20-16. Died 12-16-1918.

13. McCLURE, R.N., Gainesville, Ga. Co. I 52nd Ga. Regt., Cause for pension: Viscerose veins. Witness: R.F. Smith MD, E.E. Dixon MD. Pension 1914 through 1916, paid to widow 4-19-1916. Died Nov. 19, 1916.

14. MASON, E.C., Flowery Branch, Rte. 3, Co. C Cobb Legions. Cause for pension: disabled arm 1863. Pension 1914 through 1916. Died Oct. 11, 1916.

15. PRUITT, Nathan, Co. G. 24th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: loss leg. Witness: A. Rudolph, Ordy. Pension 1914

through 1915. Paid widow 4-17-1914. Died 12-17-1913.

16. PUCKETT, D.H., Buford, Ga., Rte 2. Co. H 36th Ga. Regt. Reason for pension: disabled arm. Witness, R.F. Smith MD. Pension 1914 through 1916. Transferred from disabled roll to Service Roll 12-12-1915.

17. POOL, J.B., Lula, Ga. Co. I 24th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: Head wound. Witness, Levi Broom MD, Noah Martin. Pension 1914 through 1921.

18. REED, R.S., Oakwood, Ga. Co. D 55 Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: running sore from old wound. Witness: W.N. Dyer, Ordy, and W.G. Ham MD. Pension 1914 through 1915. Paid widow 2-22-1915. Died 1-1-1916, 7:00 a.m.

19. REYNOLDS, W.W., Flowery Branch, Ga., Rte. 3, Co. K. 60th Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: loss of arm. Pension 1914 through 1921.

20. SMITH, J.M., Gainesville, Rte. 7. Co. K 43rd Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: body wound 1864. Witness: S.T. Looper MD, J.W. Oalin MD, Pension 1914 through 1917, transferred to Service Roll.

21. SMITH, Russell, Gainesville, Cobb Legions. Cause for pension: shoulder wound 1863. Witness: J.W. Oalin MD. Pension 1914 through 1920. Died 9-19-1920.

22. SULLINS, A.E., 1st National Bank. Capt. Kelly Co. Cavalry. Cause for pension: disabled leg by fall. Witness: R.F. Smith MD. Pension 1914 through 1921.

23. SMITH, R.D., Gainesville, Rte. 8, Co. (?), 22nd Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: foot wound. Witness: T.O. Otwell. Pension 1914 through 1921.

24. SHORE, R.M., Lula, Ga., Rte 2. Co. A 7th Ga. Cav. Pension 1914 through 1917. Died May 1917.

25. TURNER, L.L., Co. D 21st Regt. Witness: H.L. Hawkins, A. Strickland. Pension 1914 through 1920. Paid to widow 5-14-1920. Died 2-4-1920. Transferred from Forsyth Co. 8-5-1916.

26. WALLIS, Harvy C., Co. I 30th Regt. Witness: C.A.

Davenport and T.L. Lipscomb. Pension in 1921. Transferred from Forsyth Co. 12-16-1920.

27. WHITE, G.B., Buford, Ga., Rte 3, when entered: 1-1864. Co. A 1st Ga. Regt. Cause for pension: loss of eye. Witness: J.S. Pirkie, I.S. Hendri and W.P. Wheeler all from Forsyth Co., Ga. Pension 6-26-1917 through 1921.
