

## Vincent Lockhart

## Agreement between the heirs of Vincent Lockhart decd.

State of Georgia,

Hall County } Whereas it is known to Vincent D. Lockhart and Brittain M. Lockhart of the State of Georgia, and Susan M. Thomas of the State of Arkansas that their Father Vincent Lockhart having begun many years ago to divide his property between his three children above named, with the express intention of giving to each one an equal share, and,

Whereas the said Vincent Lockhart on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August One thousand, eight hundred and eighty-nine departed this life without having fully accomplished his desire in regard to the distribution of his estate, and without leaving any written or lawful will; and,

Whereas it appears from receipts, notes and due bills found among his papers after his death that V. D. Lockhart had received (\$394<sup>11</sup>) Three Hundred and Ninety-four Dollars and seventy seven cents, that B. M. Lockhart received (\$486<sup>23</sup>) Four Hundred and eighty Dollars and Eighty three cents, and that Susan M. Thomas had received (\$341<sup>2</sup>) Three Hundred and forty one Dollars.

Therefore in order that B. M. Lockhart, the Adm<sup>r</sup>. of the Estate of said deceased, may divide said estate in accordance with the expressed desire of said deceased, it is hereby entered into and agreed upon between B. M. Lockhart, Adm<sup>r</sup>. of the first part, and V. D. Lockhart and Susan M. Thomas of the second part that in the distribution of said Estate V. D. Lockhart shall receive eighty-six dollars and six cents (\$86.26) and Susan M. Thomas shall receive One Hundred and thirty-nine Dollars and Eighty three cents and afterwards what remains shall be divided equally between V. D. Lockhart, B. M. Lockhart, and Susan M. Thomas.

And it is further agreed between said heirs that of the notes and due bills found against said heirs there shall not be charged, counted or added any interest whatever, to them, their heirs, executors, administrators or assigns from the day said notes were given till the day they are set-

So all to whom these Presents shall come or be made known - Greeting.

Whereas B. M. Lockhart Adm<sup>r</sup>. of the Estate of Vincent Lockhart decd, hath made application for the dismission thereof; and on examination of the inventory & returns of said estate & having found all & singular the property of said estate which came to the hands of said B.
