my body do make and constitute this my last
will and Testament in manner and form following
Item I give and bequeath my body to the dust
from whence it was taken in full Assurance of
its Resurrection from thence through the merits of
my Compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ. As to
my worldly Estate I dispose of in the following
manner. Item. I give and bequeath unto my
Brother Levi Bourden one Negra man named
Asham to him and his Heirs forever I also give
unto my said Brother Levi Bourden six hundred
Dollars in Cash to him & his Heirs forever
Item I give and and Bequeath unto my Sister
Mary Saunders one Negro Man named Tom
to her and her Heirs forever. I Also give unto my
said Sister Mary Saunders all my my house
hold and Kitchen Furniture to her and her Heirs
forever I likewise give unto my said Sister Mary
Saunders all my Reading Books of every Description
to her & her Heirs forever Item I give and bequeath
unto my Nephew Joseph Sarnett and my two Nieces
Polly and Sally Sarnett's Eight Hundred Dollars
to be equally divided between them at they come of
age or marry and my desire further is that my
Executors herofore named shall lend out the above
mentioned Sum of Eight Hundred Dollars annually
with the Interest arising therefrom untill one of the above
mentioned Children comes of age or marries and then
for the said Child arrived to age or marriage receive

his or her part of the said Eight Hundred \$
Dollars and the Interest arising therefrom & then
the remainder to be lent out as before untill one
of the others arrives to age or marry's and then
for that to draw his ~~part~~ her part in proportion
as before and so to continue untill the last
Child comes of age or marry's then I give unto
my Brother Levi Borden & my sister Mary
Saunders all the remainder of my Estate be it
of whatsoever kind it may be ^{to be} divided equally
between ~~between~~ them to them & their heirs forever.
Then I nominate and Appoint my Brother in
Law William Saunders my whole and sole
Executor of this my last will and Testament.
