Hancock County } Miller of the County & State aforesaid do make this
my last will & testament through weak in body and strong in mind
1st I bequeath my soul to God who gave it.

2nd I will that all my just debts be paid -

3rd I give to my wife Elizabeth Miller during her natural life or
widowhood the use of the land whereon I now reside together
with the Stock, Kitchen and Household furniture during her
lifetime or widowhood, at her death or marriage the Land to go
to my son William Miller.

4th I give to my daughter Mary Miller a Horse to be raised out
of the Stock above mentioned also two Cows & Calves 1 Bed
bedstead & furniture known as hers at this time -

5th I give to my son James Miller one grey mare which he has
in possession, one Cow & Calf when called for, one Bed, bedstead &
furniture known as his by claim -

6th I give to my son John Miller a Horse to be raised out of the
Stock as above when convenient to his mother, one good Bed
bedstead & furniture, also one Cow & Calf.

7th I give to my daughter ^{Elizabeth} Miller one Horse & Saddle & Whiffles
if it can be raised out of the Stock when she arrives to
Womanhood, one Bed, bedstead & furniture, one Cow & Calf one yearling

8th I give to my son William Miller a Horse to be raised out
of the Stock, one Bed, bedstead & furniture known as his
one Cow & two yearlings known as his at this time -

9th In case of my wife Marrying she is to take one third part of the
perishable property after furnishing the above statements. In case
of her death or at her death the balance of Stock, Kitchen &
Household furniture to be equally divided amongst all of my
children.

Lastly, I appoint my son James Miller together with my trusty
friend Benjamin Sanford my true & lawful Executors.
