RULE NISI.

On the petition of the Heirs of Charles Clarke, dec. stating that their ancestor was possessed of a certain Deed of Conveyance, made by Richard Call and Aletha Call, to said Charles Clarke, for 500 acres of land in the county of Wilkes (now Hancock); and that said Deed is lost, so that it cannot be obtained—and praying that a copy may be established in lieu of the original, accompanied with the necessary affidavits to establish the same.

On motion for the petitioners, it is ordered, that, the said Copy be established in lieu of the original; on the said heirs publishing this rule in one of the public Gazettes of this state, once a month for six months—unless good cause be shewn against the same.
