She has also the privilege of lending to any
of my children during her natural life
any property she may think fit

Item - After the death of my wife it is my will
& desire and I do hereby direct that all the
property that may be remaining as well that
which may have been loaned by my wife
as that in her possession at the ^{time} of her death
be equally divided amongst all my children
except Povey H. Langston who will receive
the sum of ~~500~~ ⁵⁰⁰ dollars -

executrix and Richard H Adams executor of
this my last will and testament -
