Item. It is my will and desire that Alexander J. Harwell do have six negroes, namely Salt, Ellect, Cam, Myrtle, Dick, & yellow Ben to him, his heirs and assigns forever—

Item. I give unto Mrs. Harwell four children namely Thomas G., Alexander J., Mark G. & Polly Mason Harwell all my estate in Virginia to be equally divided between the above named children to them their heirs and assigns forever, the property in Virginia consist of one tract of land known held by John D. Maclin, one negro man Sam, a certain sum of money held by Sampson A. Robinson and my proportionable part of my mother's estate at her death—

I do nominate Green Hitchell my Executor and Guardian for the above named children the above named children is not to have their property untill they arrive to the age of twenty-one or marry in witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand & Seal this twenty-third day of September, one thousand eight hundred & ~~thirteen~~ ^{thirteen}
