We whose names is hereunto subscribed being called on by the Administrators and Legates of Stephen Evans decd. they all being of lawful age, have attended at the late dwelling house of said decd. for the purpose of making an equal division among the Legates of said decd. and after taking into view as near as possible the amount of property which the decd. had at his death, his in his lifetime together with the whole amount of Sales made by the Administrators, amounting in the total sum to eight thousand three hundred and forty seven dollars 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ which sum being divided in Twelve distributive shares agreeable to the number of legates which gives to each Legate the sum of six hundred and ninety five dollars & 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ cts. in the whole. We do hereby certify that the same has been so divided and distributed among the Legates as aforesaid. Witness our hands and seals this 15th day of November 1815.

To John Evans the sum of two hundred & forty seven dollars 65 cents with the sum of four hundred & forty-eight dollars rec^d of the dec^d in his life time -

To Abner Evans the sum of three hundred & forty-six dollars 40 1/2 cents with the sum of three hundred & forty-nine dollars 25 which he rec^d from the dec^d in his life time -

To Henry Turner who intermarried with one of the legates the sum of one hundred & forty-seven dollars 65 cents with the sum of five hundred & forty-eight dollars rec^d from the dec^d in his lifetime.

To James Farley who intermarried with one of the legates the sum of three hundred & sixty-one dollars 65 cents with the sum of three hundred & thirty-four dollars which he rec^d from the dec^d in his life time -

To Nath Evans the sum of three hundred & thirty dollars, which with the sum of three hundred & sixty-five dollars which he rec^d from the dec^d in his life time make the full amount of six hundred & ninety-five dollars 65 cents -

To David Evans the sum of seven hundred & twenty dollars which he rec^d from the dec^d in his life time over paying his share by the sum of twenty-four dollars 35 cents -

To Sam^l Daniell who intermarried with one of the legates the sum of three hundred & thirty-seven dollars 65 cents with the sum of three hundred & fifty-eight which he rec^d from the dec^d in his lifetime -

To Stephen Evans the sum of one hundred & five dollars 65 cents with the sum of five hundred & ninety dollars which he rec^d from the dec^d in his life time -

To Russell Rogers who intermarried with one of the legates the sum of one hundred & seventy-three dollars 65 cents with the sum of five hundred & twenty-two dollars which he rec^d before -

To the widow Mrs Phoebe Evans the sum of ninety-five dollars & 65 cents with two negroes Sarah & Emily valued to be six hundred dollars she taking a child first & making an equal legate. Given under our hands this 10th October 1816.
