It is ordered and adjudged by this Court that said Will be deemed legally proven, and that it be admitted to record.

Whereas I, Abel Pugh of the County and State aforesaid am advanced in years and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die, and calling to remembrance that my end approaches nigh, and whereas God hath blessed me with some of this world's goods which I desire that my sons and daughters should have the sole benefit of after my death and now being in my proper senses and reason do hereby declare this to be my last Will and testament which is as follows. First of all I recommend my body to the grave and my soul to God who gave it.

2nd I desire that my lawful debts be paid out of my estate.

3rd I give and bequeath to my son William all that part of my land on the West side of the Creek also one bay filly two years old last spring, also one half of the stock of sheep the other half to Thomas.

4 I also give and bequeath unto my son Thomas all the remainder of my land whereas I now live, also one several mares and colts also all the stock of Cattle and hogs also one feather bed and furniture.
